**NEW CPMF TREATMENT FOR “GUMMY SMILE” FEATURES
QUICKER RECOVERY, LESS COST, AND MORE PREDICTABLE RESULTS**

GRAND RAPIDS, MICHIGAN, June 6, 2011—Grand Rapids periodontist David Lamberts, DDS wants to get the word out that there’s a less invasive, great new way to enhance a “gummy smile.” In the past, the primary solution has been to trim up excess gum tissue and reveal more tooth structure.

The new technique Dr. Lamberts is now performing has an elegantly simple, yet effective approach. “I am able to modify a hyper mobile lip with Coronally Positioned Mucosal Flap surgery (CPMF),” says Dr. Lamberts, “Surgery, which is done in our office with local anesthesia. During CPMF, gum tissue under the lip is surgically reattached to restrict the lip from raising excessively upward with smiling. An added benefit of the procedure is that the upper lip may also appear fuller when smiling.”

New materials, technology and microsurgical procedures have made it possible to correct smile imperfections that would have been impossible to fix even five years ago.
